Transition Town Totnes acts as a catalyst for the Totnes and district to explore how to prepare for and adapt to life beyond cheap oil and gas. It is positive, solutions-focused and fun. In the 16 months since its 'Unleashing' it has become an energetic driver of a range of projects and initiatives in the town, and has inspired an international movement of over 400 cities, towns and villages. Its core message is a simple one, that the future with less oil could be preferable to the present, if we can engage sufficiently in advance with enough imagination, creativity and adaptability. Some of the manifestations of its work that you might have seen include;

- The Totnes Pound, now in its third phase and accepted at over 70 local businesses
- 'Transition Tales', a project working with local schools
- 'A Celebration of Local Food', a local food directory
- The planting of nut bearing trees in the town
- 'Estates in Transition', a 1 day conference with local landowners
- 'Garden Share', linking gardeners with owners of underused gardens
- Submitted a detailed response to the Totnes DPD.

This new programme marks a move away from featuring mostly talks, to prioritising activities and practical projects, as TTT moves into its next phase. We also run Home Groups where local people meet to support each others Transition work. Contact the office for more details. We are always looking for volunteers, and also for donations and support. 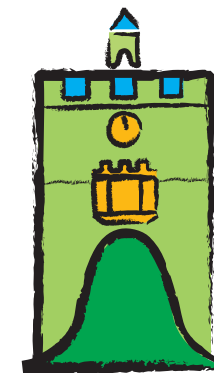
