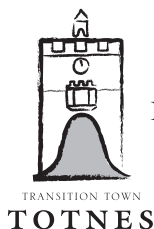

Transition Town Totnes acts as a catalyst for Totnes to explore how to prepare for and adapt to life beyond cheap oil and gas. Some of the key projects it has sparked include:

- The Totnes Pound, the town's local currency which recently was featured in the Buenos Aires Herald!
- 'Transition Tales', a project working with local schools to raise awareness about energy issues
- The Totnes International Youth Music Festival
- The delivery of £1,500 worth of books on various aspects of sustainability to Totnes library
- A series of Open Space days on a range of subjects
- Presenting Prince Charles with a Totnes Pound
- Publishing 'A Celebration of Local Food', a local food directory
- A World Café discussion seminar with local councillors
- The planting of nut bearing trees in the town
- 'Estates in Transition', a 1 day conference for local landowners

The momentum being generated in Totnes and the enthusiasm with which it has been received continues to be extraordinary, inspiring others to set up projects modeled on the Totnes experience. The Transition Network, a charity set up to support the many Transition Initiatives now springing up around the country is based here in Totnes.

"Whether we like it or not the world faces a major transition away from dependence on fossil fuels. Either we will decide to manage that transition for the maximum benefit of everyone, or we will be managed by it in a way that is likely to be messy, dangerous and potentially lethal for millions. 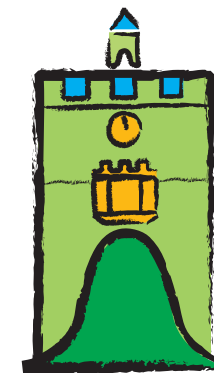

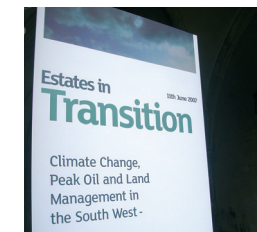
